

What happens when your child is referred to our Community Paediatric Service



The support package can include:

- Support and advice based on their individual needs, including within their education setting
- An invite to drop-in sessions
- Additional specialist assessments if clinically indicated
- Blood pressure and growth monitoring

The young person may also be booked to see a paediatrician for a specialist assessment.

Not all young people referred to us will need to see a paediatrician for their needs to be met.

They may see another member of our team, such as:

- Specialist nurse
- Autism specialist teacher
- Therapist
- Clinical support worker
